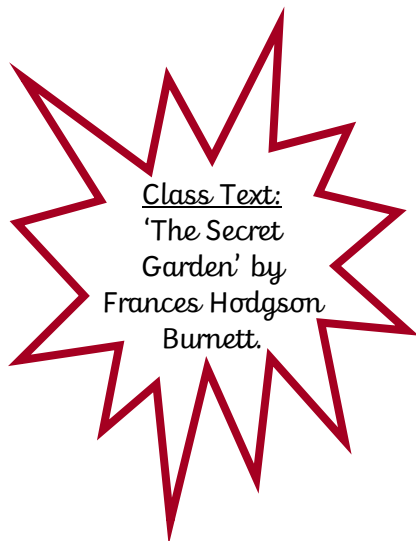

Sow, Grow and Farm

What is this about?

In the Sow, Grow and Farm project, your child will learn about allotments in the United Kingdom and how the government encouraged people to have them to support food rationing during the Second World War. They will learn about food webs and animal life cycles, including how living things are dependent on one another within a habitat. They will investigate the different ways that plants reproduce and will dissect flowering plants to identify the different structures.

Why is this relevant to us?

They will have the opportunity to learn about farming in the United Kingdom which is important as it surrounds a rural village like Barwick and the techniques used in modern farming, including the challenges that farmers face. They will learn about the benefits of eating seasonally and about the pros and cons of importing food, which is relevant as all children have experience with cooking or eating food.
