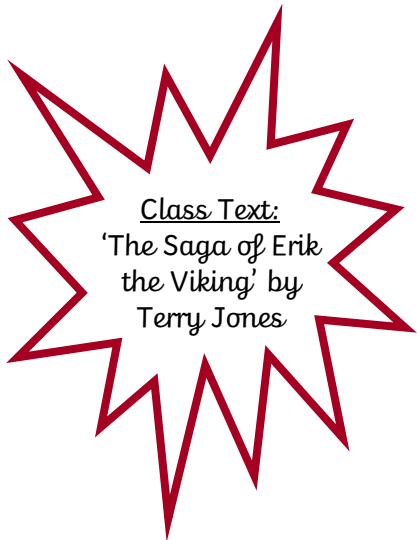

**Driver Project (History)**  
**Invasion**

**What is this about?**

In our Invasion Project Oak Class will learn about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal of 410AD. Children will learn about the Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasions up to the Norman conquest including the threat posed by the Picts.

They will also compare Anglo-Saxon life with that of the Vikings and look at the causes and consequences of the Viking invasions.

They will learn about the legacy left by King Athelstan and what this tells us about daily life in Anglo-Saxon times. The children will study what led up to the Battle of Hastings with the fight over the British crown.

**Why is this relevant to us?**

This time period of British History is important as it demonstrates the development of other civilisations once the Roman Empire collapsed and shows the last successful invasion on mainland Britain with the Norman Conquest.
